Recognized as one of Canada's best wildlife artists, **Clinton Jammer** was raised in the small community of Port Perry, Ontario. A completely self-taught artist, he began drawing in pen and ink when he was three or four years of age, but it wasn't until his late 20's that Clinton began to approach painting seriously. He has always been an avid supporter of nature and wildlife conservation, and over the years, has raised tens of thousands of dollars for various organizations and causes through donated paintings and sponsored print sales.

Clinton's paintings are highly detailed and realistic (often mistaken as photographs in fact), and each reflects the strong influence nature has always had on his life. Fishing, canoeing, portaging and back country camping have been his hobbies (and passions) since he was a young boy, each excursion leaving fond and powerful memories etched into his soul.

As a Wildlife Artist, there's always something on Clinton's wildlife research trip wish list. So, when he's not in his studio painting, you can find him either travelling the globe gathering first-hand research of all species of wildlife in their natural habitat or planning the next excursion! So far, Clinton has travelled to South Africa, Botswana, Alaska, British Columbia, Yukon Territory, Northwest Territories, Colombia, St. Lucia, Costa Rica, Yellowstone National Park and Brazil.
